Welcome to the Airwise Flying Group! Here are some simple guidelines to help us operate our group in a safe and relaxed way while avoiding a long list of rules.

NEW JOINERS / GENERAL ADVICE
☐ Please take the time to learn about the aircraft. Especially if you have only flown school aircraft before.
\square Consider putting the tow on charge while you are out flying the aircraft
\square Stow everything away tidily in the locker to prevent any damage.
□ Please use WhatsApp for any aircraft/booking information that is time-critical
☐ Unfortunately, ride-sharing websites are not permitted. However, members are encouraged to arrange shared flights
☐ If you are unsure about any aspect of aircraft operation — please ask - "better safe than sorry", advice will be provided quickly with no judgement ☺
BOOKING THE AIRCRAFT
☐ Be mindful that some members are restricted to certain days or weekends
□ Only book what you need - most flights are <90 mins and don't need a full-day.
□ Remember to cancel your unused bookings, e.g. in the event of bad weather
\square Do any cancellations as early as possible, then let members know it's free
☐ Please ask members via WhatsApp, if you would prefer to swap a slot
☐ Please avoid booking more than 4 flights in advance.
☐ Contact the group in advance before booking <u>consecutive</u> days
\square Take the time to learn about the booking patterns of other members.
CLEANING THE AIRCRAFT
□ Please try to keep the aircraft clean and flying well, especially when landing on muddy fields. There is a handy hose near Hangar 1 which makes this easier.
\square Please wipe any dead bugs off the windscreen with a wet cloth prior to next flight
☐ Always leave the aircraft <u>better</u> than you found it. Removing any rubbish
GETTING INVOLVED
\square Please provide your suggestions for improvements to communications
☐ Any new equipment requests need agreement by the group
☐ Share occasional updates in WhatsApp, but remember we are not Facebook!
